

Guaranteed Admission Requirements for the following Kansas Community Colleges:

Barton County, Butler, Coffeyville, Cloud County, Colby, Dodge City, Fort Scott, Garden City, Highland, Hutchinson, Johnson County, Kansas City Kansas, Labette, Neosho County, Seward County.

1. An unencumbered active RN license issued in the United States.
2. Cumulative GPA or Associate in Nursing Degree GPA ≥ 2.5 . Students that do not meet the Cumulative GPA or Associate in Nursing Degree GPA ≥ 2.5 may be admitted on probation if their cumulative GPA and Associate in Nursing Degree is 2.0-2.49.
3. Must have earned a "C" or better in any FHSU RN to BSN course and have a ≥ 2.5 FHSU Major GPA that was taken prior to applying.
4. International students with an F1 or F2 visa do not qualify for this program.
5. Must meet university requirements for any transfer credits.
6. We do not accept applications from students residing in Tennessee, Washington, and Alabama.

University requirements include:

- Students who have a current U.S. RN license with transcripts from outside the United States must have two evaluations completed on his/her transcripts: [WES+](#) and [CGFNS](#).
- Students whose native language is not English are required to take the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL).

BSN Program requirements include:

The Clinical Clearance Requirements must be met prior to enrollment of course NURS 449. Students will use the CastleBranch system to upload documents. *(Clinical site & preceptor establishment also required prior to enrollment of NURS 449)*
