## ADMISSION REQUIREMENT CHECKLIST

### Requirements YOU will check off:

- Admission to Teacher Education program
- Successful completion of all applicable professional education and teaching methods major/minor courses
- 2.75 cumulative GPA or 2.75 GPA on your last 60 hours of college coursework
- 2.75 major GPA
- 2.75 minor GPA (if applicable)
- Submission of Application for Student Teaching

### Requirements WE will check off:

- Departmental approval for student teaching
- Council on Preparation of Teachers and School Personnel (COPTSP) approval for student teaching (Will be internally confirmed)

### Requirements you should anticipate completing for student teaching\*:

- National background check OR Kansas teaching license - Submit or confirm that you've submitted (via Sonia) verification of having a clear National background check from within the last 4 years or verification of having a current/valid Kansas teaching license
- Negative TB Verification - Submit or confirm that you've submitted (via Sonia) verification of having a negative TB test within the last 4 years
- Professional liability insurance coverage - Submit or confirm that you've submitted (via Sonia) verification of having active professional liability insurance through your student teaching semester.
- Successful completion of the Code of Conduct/Ethics module
- Completion and submission of other required forms (via Sonia)
