- Hours from endorsement program can be used to move over on most district salary schedules
- First two courses offered 100% online, third course offered 100% online with hours for practicum experience completed locally
- Endorsement can be completed within 6 months

- Endorsement automatically renews when you renew your Kansas teaching license
- Guidance on the licensure process at completion of the program

HOW TO GET STARTED

1. Apply to FHSU Graduate School
<https://wd1-student.myworkdaysite.com/fhsu/GradStudentSite02>
2. In Program of Study, select Driver Education Graduate Non-Degree
3. Select the semester, campus location: Virtual, pay \$40 Application Fee
4. Submit a copy of unofficial Bachelor's transcript showing degree conferred from a regionally accredited institution, email to gradschool@fhsu.edu.

FHSU is offering the approved course program, the required element for the Drivers' Education endorsement. At the completion of the program, you will submit a KSDE Form 1 application to add the endorsement to your current Kansas teaching license. FHSU will verify that you have completed our approved Driver Education Program and forward the application to KSDE. KSDE will verify that you hold a currently valid Kansas teaching license and upon receipt of the application fee, will add the endorsement to your teaching license acknowledging that you have completed all the credentials needed to teach in a public driver education program and that KSDE allows you to do so.
