Hover over Advising


Click on Advisee List

DEADLINES: ACCESS TO SUCCESS-STUDENT SUCCESS PLAN

As we start back with the Spring 2014 semester, I wanted to take the opportunity to remind you of the deadlines for your 3 advisor meetings this semester for your ACCESS to Success - Student Success Plan. It is important that you meet with your advisor by these deadlines & mark the date & times on your ACCESS Plan tab within TigerEnroll. Failure to do so may result in a hold being placed on your enrollment for the next semester.

- 1. Friday, February 7 Deadline for your first meeting with your advisor. The purpose of this meeting is to discuss how the Fall 2013 semester ended for you as well as a check-in for the beginning of the Spring 2014 semester.
- 2. Friday, April 4 Deadline for your second meeting with your advisor. The purpose of this meeting is to discuss your Spring 2014 mid-term grades.
- 3. Friday, May 2 Deadline for your final meeting with your advisor. The purpose of this meeting is to pre-enroll in courses for the Fall 2014 semester.
