# COMMENCEMENT LINE OF MARCH

As stated in the *Faculty and Unclassified Staff Handbook*, "<u>ALL FACULTY ARE EXPECTED TO MARCH IN THE FORMAL ACADEMIC PROCESSION AT THE SPRING UNDERGRADUATE COMMENCEMENT</u>." Please remember dress is academic regalia with appropriate footwear. Your cooperation in maintaining a professional look is appreciated.

Assembly for the line of march will be inside M.C. Cunningham Hall at 9:30 a.m. on Saturday, May 18. Undergraduate Commencement ceremonies will begin at 10:00 a.m. Below are the instructions for the faculty march and the order you will enter the coliseum.

Undergraduate Commencement practice is Friday, May 17, at 1:45 p.m. Participation in the practice would be a great advantage to all.

We will again be providing an opportunity for our graduates to meet with their professors/instructors for conversation and pictures. After the ceremony, please proceed to the "Victor E. Lounge" (located by Gate 3) to greet your students. Hopefully, this gathering will give everyone a chance to say "farewell" or "good luck." Beverages will be provided.

# **Line of March Instructions**

# **Faculty**

Faculty will be asked to line up in four lines. The order of each line will be posted on the walls in Cunningham Hall. There will be a line of faculty entering the coliseum on the outside left aisle, inside left aisle, inside right aisle and the outside right aisle. The two **Faculty Marshals**, **Josephine Squires and Helen Miles**, will walk down the <u>inside aisle</u> into the coliseum – leading in left and right inside aisle faculty. <u>Outside aisle</u> faculty will enter at the same time but will immediately proceed down their designated outside left or outside right row. The Faculty Marshals will take their seat in front of the stage, one on each side. When the first faculty of each line reaches the front rows of seating, they will stop and stand next to the front chair. Each faculty member following these individuals will also stop and stand beside the next corresponding seat. Faculty are asked to remain standing facing the inside aisle as the candidates are led to their seats.

### **Candidates**

Candidates will be lined up in two lines and will enter down the inside aisle. Leading in the candidates will be **Candidate Marshals**, <u>Janet Stramel and Micol Maughan</u>. The remaining order is:

- Undergraduate Marshal, John Greathouse.
- College of Education and Technology (COET) Flag Bearer, Robert Moody, followed by the COET Marshals, Kim Stewart and Germaine Taggart, followed by the COET Undergraduate candidates.
- College of Business and Entrepreneurship (COBE) Flag Bearer, Melissa Hunsicker-Walburn, followed by the COBE Marshals, Dosse Toulaboe and Charles Gnizak, followed by the COBE Undergraduate candidates.
- College of Health and Life Sciences (CHLS) Flag Bearer, <u>Amy Finch</u>, followed by the CHLS Marshals, <u>Robert Stephenson and Carol Moore</u>, followed by the CHLS Undergraduate candidates.
- College of Arts & Sciences (COAS) Flag Bearer, <u>Chapman Rackaway</u>, followed by the COAS Marshals, <u>Brett Zollinger and Sharon Graham</u>, followed by the COAS Undergraduate candidates.

The Candidate Marshals, <u>Janet Stramel and Micol Maughan</u>, lead in candidates and then take their place in front of the stage, one on each side. The remaining candidates will march around the front row (the right column going right; the left column going left) filling the rows from the outside. Faculty will need to step aside a little and allow the candidates to fill in the rows. The chairs will be marked indicating "faculty member" and individual names of marshals. As the candidates fill the rows, the faculty member and/or marshal on the outside aisles will then step into that row in front of their assigned seats. Everyone will remain standing.

Seating for the college marshals will be on the outside aisles next to their candidates. Each college marshals' chair will be marked with their name on it. Faculty sitting in the same row with assigned marshals will be seated on the inside chair next to the marshals. Chairs for faculty will be marked "faculty member" and chairs for marshals will have their individual names on them.

This procedure continues until all of the candidates and marshals are in place. At this time, the faculty standing in the inside aisles will step into their rows and stand in front of their chair. Any remaining faculty members are asked to fill in the rows at the back and remain standing.

Handicapped or physically challenged faculty may wait at Gate 1 (which is where the Platform Party lines up). There will be chairs available for seating. As the faculty processional approaches, faculty waiting at Gate 1 will take their appropriate place in line and march in with the rest of the faculty. There will be assistance at Gate 1 in finding your places in line. For those of you who would like to take advantage of this, please notify Stephanie Johnson in the Registrar's office at 4320.

When the processional is completed and all are in their places, the program will begin.
