

## A GUIDE TO NORTH DAKOTA'S ENVIRONMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS

*Environmental Directory for North Dakota*. Paul B. Kannowski, Editor. 1978. Institute for Ecological Studies Special Publication No. 2, University of North Dakota, Grand Forks. 70 pages. \$3.00 (paper).

This guide is a North Dakota version of the National Wildlife Federation's valuable *Conservation Directory*. As such, it should serve the needs of individuals doing environmental business in the state.

The Directory contains four sections. The first lists "Environmental and Professional Organizations," including national (with chapters in North Dakota), state, and local groups. Included are names, addresses, and telephone numbers of pertinent officers. The second section lists federal, state, and regional "Agencies with Environmentally-related Missions." The third is devoted to "Local Government Units."

The fourth section, "Environmental Facilities," should be of particular interest to readers of *The Prairie Naturalist*. In it are listed arboretums, biological field stations, zoos, national wildlife refuges (erroneously termed "game" refuges), state game and lake management areas, historic sites, state and national parks, museums, and research centers.

This book is very welcome, and, if kept current by future editions, will be referred to often.
