- a. Cabinet met August 23.
  - i. The new Tuition Reimbursement policy was approved.
  - The Workflex Policy was discussed, and several revisions were recommended. Joe Bain will bring it back in September for third reading and vote.
  - iii. Dana Cunningham shared that the work on Campus Drive will cut 37 parking spaces, 16 of which are staff spaces. He said these staff spaces will be recreated on the south side of the street, so no net loss. He doesn't anticipate a problem with student spaces, due to earlier extra spaces added when the lot by Stroup was built, and the reduced number of students on campus.

Also, calls for increasing state-level oversight regarding extra days off at holidays means that institutional presidents will not be able to provide these days without approval. Various school senates shared ways they are addressing this, and trying to secure some extra time, so that their staff members do not have to turn in vacation time over holiday breaks.

Did discuss Staff Senate focus on compensation, recognition, as well as improving staff morale. A key point that Elodie brought up we wonder what our purpose on these shared governance groups is to disseminate the information. Information is not always coming down the proper chains.

- iii. AAUP (Nicole Frank) Working on bylaw change in order to move election of the president (this position only) from spring to fall. This will allow for job shadow of president role for nearly a year before taking office.
