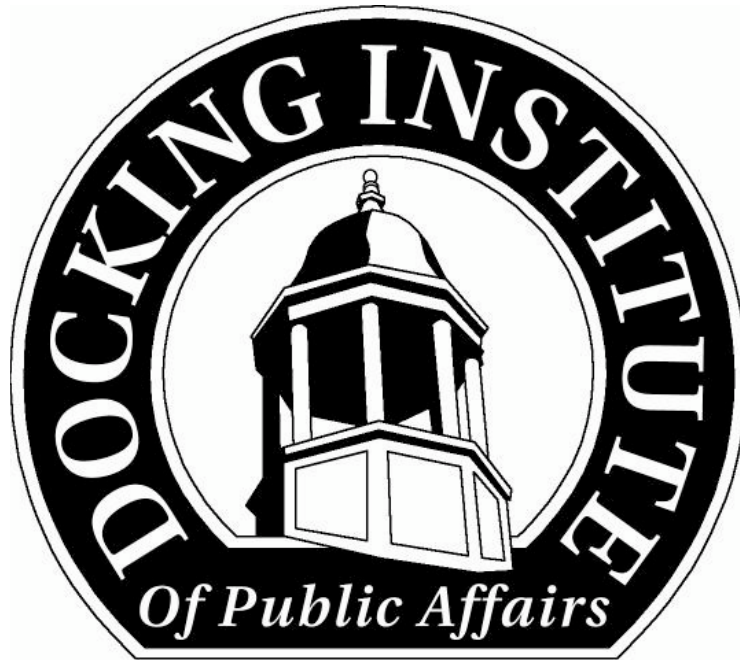
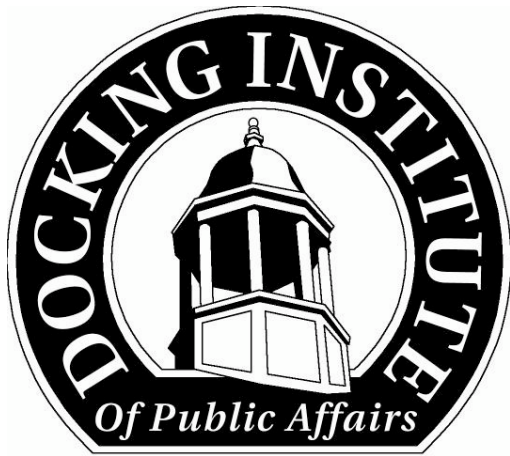

Summary
