2022-2023 **Financial Aid Application Checklist For New Students**

Ste	Step 1 – Review Options for Paying for College					
	Put time on your side. Applying for and receiving financial aid can take several weeks, even months, depending on your individual circumstances. Apply early and respond promptly to requests for information and action. Review all available options to assist you in paying for college, including grants, loans, scholarships, workstudy, personal savings, etc. For more information about types of aid, visit https://www.fhsu.edu/finaid/types-of-aid/ . Estimate your cost to attend college. Your Cost of Attendance is an estimate of the total amount it will cost you to go to college, including tuition and fees, books and supplies, room and board, loan origination fees, travel expenses, parking fees, and personal/miscellaneous expenses. To estimate your COA at FHSU, go to https://www.fhsu.edu/finaid/Forms/ , and select the "Cost of Attendance Worksheet." Current FHSU tuition and fee schedules are available at https://www.fhsu.edu/sfs/students parents/tuition/. Tuition and fee rates for 2022-23 will be finalized in early July 2022.

	Apply for admission to FHSU. Visit https://www.fhsu.edu/admissions/admissions-application/ _for more information. NOTE: Financial aid will not be awarded until you have applied for admission and have been accepted as a degree seeking student at FHSU.					
	Send all official college academic transcripts to the FHSU Registrar's Office, 600 Park Street, Hays, KS 67601 if you have taken any college coursework at another institution. In most cases, aid cannot be calculated until all transcripts are received and reviewed by the Registrar's Office.					
Step 3 – Activate your TigerNetID and Check your Email Regularly						
	Activate your TigerNetID account by visiting https://www.fhsu.edu/tigertech/new-student-information/ Upon activating your TigerNetID, you can sign into Workday. 1) Login to Workday, 2) click on the "myFHSU" tab, 3) click on the "Financial Aid Eligibility" tab under "Financials," and 4) select the "Your Documents" tab. Regularly check your Workday account for updated information. Check your email regularly for information from FHSU. We send most of our correspondence by email notification to the email address you provide on the FAFSA. Our emails will usually contain links to Workday to view your specific information (including award offers) and read messages.					
Ste	p 4 – Apply for Scholarships					
	Apply for FHSU scholarships online at https://www.fhsu.edu/finaid/Scholarships . The priority deadline for FHSU Scholarships is November 15, 2021, and the final deadline is February 15, 2022. Complete the State of Kansas Student Aid Application online at http://www.kansasregents.org/scholarships and grants if you are a State of Kansas Scholar. Priority deadline is May 1, 2022. Search for other scholarship opportunities on the FHSU Scholarship Search webpage - https://www.fhsu.edu/Scholarship.aspx.					
Step 5 – Apply for Federal Financial Aid – Priority Deadline: December 1, 2021						
	Obtain a Federal Student Aid FSA ID which consists of a username and password combination that allows you to sign your FAFSA electronically. Your FSA ID can be used to sign loan contracts and to access certain information online. You can get your

Review your Student Aid Report (SAR), which is sent to you via e-mail or postal mail after you file the FAFSA, for accuracy. If you filed your FAFSA online, you should receive your SAR within 5-7 days.

☐ Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) online at studentaid.gov. You should complete your FAFSA as soon after October 1, 2021 as possible but before the December 1, 2021 priority deadline. Applications are accepted after the priority deadline but limited types of aid are awarded to eligible applicants who apply first. If at all possible, use the IRS Data

	Submit any requested documents to FHSU . After November 1, the FHSU Financial Assistance Office will begin sending email notifications requesting additional information to students who have submitted a FAFSA. Please respond promptly. Contact u if you have questions.					
	Complete and submit the FHSU Financial Aid Data Form. Upon receiving an email notification requesting completion of the Financial Aid Data Form, click on "myFHSU" in Workday, and then select "Financial Aid Eligibility" under the financials tab. If you are selected for verification, be sure to respond to requests for information and complete the data form as soon as possible.					
Ste	p 8 – Accept or Decline your F	inancial Aid Offer				
	Accept or Decline your financial offer. Upon receiving email notification that your financial aid offer is pending, click on "myFHSU" in Workday, and then select "Financial Aid Eligibility" under the financials tab. You will find your award offer under the menu and accept/decline offer. Please be sure to "accept/ decline" all of your financial aid listed. Any items left at "pending" will result in a delay of your disbursement.
