General Scholarship Information

It is important to read this entire document before completing and signing the application and intent form.

General Scholarship Information

The David M. Shumaker Geology Scholarship was created to honor David M. Shumaker. Funding for the scholarship has been provided by an anonymous donor through an endowed fund. The purpose of this scholarship is to assist students who meet the following criteria:

- Must be a Geology major pursuing the Petroleum Emphasis track or have an intent form on file
- Preference given to students with plans to pursue a career in the gas and oil industry
- Preference given to students who show initiative, leadership, and work to their full academic potential
- Consideration will also be given to students who show financial need

Scholarships are limited, priority will be given to students who best meet all of the criteria and who meet the scholarship application deadline. There are ten \$1500 scholarships available for the 08-09 school year.

Scholarship Recipient Terms and Conditions

Scholarship recipients will receive 50% of the annual scholarship award during the Fall semester if the following conditions are met.

- Student must have declared Geology as a major with an emphasis in either Petroleum Operations or Petroleum Exploration
- Student must enroll in a minimum of 12 semester hours.
- Student must meet with Geology faculty to arrange appropriate course schedules (if available please attach a copy of a current transcript).
- Student must maintain a cumulative GPA of at least 2.0

The remaining 50% of the scholarship will be awarded to recipients during the Spring semester if the following conditions are met.

- Student must have declared Geology as a major with an emphasis in either Petroleum Operations or Petroleum Exploration
- Student must enroll in a minimum of 12 semester hours.
- Student must meet with Geology faculty to arrange appropriate course schedules and have received a grade of 'C' or better in the Fall semester classes (a copy of student's transcript must be attached).
- Student must maintain a cumulative GPA of at least 2.0

Students who have received this scholarship previously may apply for consecutive year funding; recipients will receive funding divided into awards of 50% each Fall and Spring semester. All terms and conditions mentioned above must have been met as well as the following.

- Student must have received a grade of 'C' or better in courses required for first year applicants. (a copy of student's transcript must be attached).
- Student must enroll in courses leading to either of the Petroleum Geology emphasis.
- Student must maintain a cumulative GPA of at least 2.0

Any scholarship recipient who fails to meet any of the above provisions may forfeit any further scholarship consideration.
