Financial Requirements for International Students

Fort Hays State University welcomes applications for admission from qualified international students. Unfortunately, the university is not in a position to offer financial assistance to non-resident students.

Application Fee to apply to Fort Hays State University is \$50 non-refundable

International students must be able to certify that the necessary funds are available to cover all necessary living and educational expenses for their entire period of proposed study. Projected educational costs for the 2009-2010 calendar year are estimated at \$19,277.00 depending upon the number of credit hours enrolled in. A breakdown of these costs are listed below.
