## **EXPIRING DOCUMENTS**



Please check your documents to make sure they are not expired!

**I-20 or DS-2019:** If your document is expiring, notify the International Office (before it expires) so you can complete a program extension form. Please note that you will be out of status if this expires. **Passport: This document must be valid at all times.** If it will be expiring, please check your country's US consular website on what to do. The passport can be renewed within the U.S. **Visa: If** this has expired, you can legally be in the U.S. but once you leave, you will have to renew your visa before re-entering the U.S.

#### **CURRENT ADDRESS & PHONE IN WORKDAY**

All international students are required to provide a current mailing address and phone number. It is important that your information stay current at all times as USCIS (U. S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement) requires our office to maintain student records in SEVIS (Student Exchange Visitor Information System).



#### Take a moment to make sure your current mailing address and phone number are updated:

- 1. Login to Workday
- 2. Select your picture or the round circle in the top right corner.
- 3. Select the "view profile" button. This will bring you to a page with a blue navigation bar on the left.
- 4. Select the "Contact" in the blue navigation bar.
- 5. Click the "Edit" drop-down box and select "Change Contact Information".
- 6. Add an address by selecting the pencil icon at the right of the box; do not change or delete your permanent address from this space. When finished, select the check mark in the right corner of the address box.
- 7. Select the yellow "Submit" button in the bottom left corner.

## **TRAVEL**

Please make sure that if you want to eat out during the winter break to call the restaurant first to make sure they are open. Their hours may be different or they maybe closed, especially on Christmas Day and New Year's Day.

Take special care if you are traveling during the holiday. Road conditions can change quickly and become quite dangerous. With the added holiday traffic, please pay attention to your surroundings and drive carefully. Pack warm clothing, some snack food, a blanket, flashlight, and water. If you have a cellphone take that and any emergency numbers you might need as well. It is also a good idea to let your friends or the International Office know where and when you plan to travel in case you run into problems. We all want to make sure you are safe during the break. Try your best to check the weather reports before you leave. You can access weather information at <a href="weather.com">weather.com</a>. For students who intend to travel outside the U.S. during the holidays, make sure you have the following before you leave:

- 1. Current Passport and Visa
- 2. Signed I-20 or DS-2019
- 3. Any documents to obtain a new visa, (if needed)

Check any COVID-19 protocols for traveling by air and country you will travel to. Please plan to arrive at the airport approximately 3 hours before any international flight you are taking. Be sure to review travel restrictions and guidelines for your destination with TSA.

Stop by the International Office on **Tuesday, December 5 from 1:30pm to 3:00pm or Wednesday, December 6 from 10:30am-12:00pm** to get your I-20 or DS-2019 signed by Carol or Angie. This is dedicated time to get signatures and ask immigration questions.

Can't make this event? No worries! You can drop off your document any time BEFORE Dec. 15 and come back the next day to pick it up. **DO NOT wait until the day before, you might not get a signature! PLAN AHEAD.**
