IMPORTANT REMINDERS



Immigration law requires all international students to enroll and remain in a full course load which constitutes 12 credit hours for undergraduate and 9 hours for graduate students. *It is also important to note, that only one on-line class can count toward full time enrollment.* If it is your last semester and you plan to apply for OPT, you cannot be enrolled in an on-line only class. If you or your advisor have questions about this, please contact our office. If it becomes necessary to withdraw from a course, and this will put you below full-time status, visit with staff in the International Office. Checking before you drop a course will avoid problems for you and your immigration status.

Remember that while school is in session, you are only allowed to work 20 hours per week on campus. It is essential to prioritize your academic commitments and avoid any interference with your coursework due to employment obligations. To ensure compliance, we will be monitoring students' work hours throughout the spring semester.

We strongly encourage you to actively engage in campus life by participating in various activities and events, joining clubs, or joining the International Student Union. Your involvement not only enriches your overall experience but also helps you build lasting connections and create memorable moments during your time here. We look forward to seeing you thrive academically and socially at FHSU.

Here are some deadlines that the Graduate School would like you to know about:

- ~Comprehensive Exam deadline to sign up is February 26
- ~Application for Degree Completion in Workday must be filed by March 8
- ~Approved Thesis or Specialist's Field Study and oral exam report is due April 29
- ~Submission of Thesis or Specialist's Field Study introductory pages for format review is due April 29
- ~Comprehensive Exam results are to be turned in by May 13

INCOME TAX RETURN INFORMATION



The office has recently sent emails regarding your 2023 tax obligations. Make sure you regularly check and read your emails to stay informed on this subject. Marnie is hosting several workshops so it will be important for you to attend these workshops to get the vital information regarding your tax obligations and for time to work on and receive assistance in completing your income tax return.

If you are a non-resident in the US and received US income in 2023, filing a tax return is a legal requirement. The deadline for this obligation is April 18, 2024. Even if you did not earn income in the US, you are still obligated to file Form 8843 with the IRS. This applies to anyone who was present in the US at any time during the 2023 year.

ON CAMPUS EMPLOYMENT



Looking for on-campus employment opportunities? Various departments/offices are actively seeking student workers. Visit our web site at https://www.fhsu.edu/international/international-services/employment/ for job assistance. F-1 and J-1 visa holders can work a maximum of 20 hours per week on campus during the school term in Non-Workstudy positions. Off-campus employment is only permitted through approved OPT or CPT. Graduate Assistantships & Graduate Teaching Assistantships count towards the weekly limit.

Our office monitors students' work hours with the Student Employment Office and Chartwells. If exceeding 20 hours, students will be contacted. For inquiries, reach out to the International Office at 785-628-4176. We prioritize your academic success and aim to prevent work interference with coursework. Internship participants must obtain CPT approval before starting their position.

TIGER LINK & CORQ



TigerLink is FHSU's student involvement system that helps students become engaged on campus and manage their experiences outside the classroom. TigerLink serves as the central calendar for student life and has groups for every registered student organization, residence hall, and living learning community on campus as well as a variety of university departments, programs, and resources.
