

## **Criteria For Admitting Graduate Students in Psychology**

### Application Requirements

Students need to submit each of the following items to the Graduate School:

- 1) Graduate Record Exam (GRE) scores.
- 2) Official transcripts of all college work.
- 3) Two completed recommendation forms (available on the psychology department website)
- 4) A personal statement in which the student describes their reasons for pursuing graduate training in psychology.
- 5) The Graduate School application form.

### Prerequisite Coursework

In general, undergraduate course background must include 15-20 hours of Psychology coursework, including a course in psychological statistics and research methods/experimental lab. Students applying for applied programs (clinical and school) should have a course in abnormal psychology.
