

ENERGIZING MIDDLE SCHOOL SCIENCE & SOCIAL STUDIES

- On campus (July 6-9 and July 13-16) and home based (July 20-23) summer workshop; on-campus housing will be provided at no cost to the participant
- 3 credit hours will be received upon completion of the summer workshop and an additional 3 for the completion of an online course during the academic year
- This workshop is Year 2 of a 3 year project focusing on science integrated with social studies—participation in Year 1 is not a requirement for involvement in Year 2
- Designed for 5th-12th grade teachers of science and/or social studies, with a preference given to middle school teachers and teams of teachers from the same school
- Participants will receive materials for activity implementation in the classroom, have the ability to collaborate with professionals and other educators, and learn effective pedagogical strategies
- \$600 stipend for the summer workshop; participants can receive an additional \$400 stipend for online course completion during the academic year as well as a \$50 stipend for attending each of the 6 required follow-up IPTV/Skype sessions (not having IPTV at your school will not hinder your selection)
- Workshop enrollment is limited to 24 participants
