

WE GO TO THE MOON

- 3 Credit hours, web-based with a 3 day face-to-face workshop in Hays (June 16, 17 & 18) with a NASA Aerospace Educator +1 day at the Cosmosphere (TBA).
- The web-based course will run from June 1 to July 23.
- Just in time for the 40th Anniversary of the Moon Landing, this course looks at the science, technology, and social implications of the early days of the moon exploration.
- In addition to the course, which is designed for teachers K-12, examples and materials are provided for standards-correlated classroom activities to infuse into your curriculum.
- A special highlight is that you will receive lunar rock certification allowing you to borrow Moon rocks for your classroom.
- Successful completion of the course will result in a stipend of \$625 which can be used to offset the course cost of \$650, that is 3 credit hours for a cost of \$25!!
- The course is limited to 24.
