- Students pay tuition and fees for all hours in which they are enrolled. Changes in residency classification can affect the amount of tuition and fees owed.
- Graduate tuition and fees are assessed based on course enrollment level rather than individual classification. Students will pay graduate tuition and fees for graduate credit courses and undergraduate tuition and fees for undergraduate credit courses.
- Special fees may be added to selective approved courses such as noncredit courses, workshops, conferences and seminars based on direct and indirect operating costs.
- Students enrolled in both on-campus and off-campus courses will pay on-campus tuition and fees for all hours, including off-campus hours. Students enrolled in at least one on-campus class during the semester will be assessed on-campus tuition and fees for all courses in which the student is enrolled. Students enrolled only in Virtual College classes will be assessed Virtual College tuition and fees for all courses in which the student is enrolled.
- Students who add or process an add/drop together at any time for the semester will have fees recalculated at the time of each transaction. These transactions may change the fee status of the student for the semester and fees will be assessed accordingly. The student is required to remit payment for additional fees owed at the time of the transaction. Refunds owed to the student will be released to the student's Tiger Card account.
- Drops with no percentage refund will not have a change in fee status for the semester. In other words, a student who is enrolled in both on-campus and off-campus courses and drops the on-campus course after the refund period would continue to pay on-campus fees.
- The bottom line is that when a student changes status (from on-campus to off-campus or from off-campus to on-campus), all courses for which there have been fees charged (including those that have had a partial refund) will be recalculated.
- Contiguous State – Students who are residents of Colorado, Missouri, Nebraska, or Oklahoma taking on-campus classes qualify for the Contiguous State Tuition Program. The FHSU Registrar makes the final determination of eligibility.
- MSEP - Undergraduate students who are residents of Minnesota, Michigan, and North Dakota can apply for classification under the Midwest Student Exchange Program. Eligibility requirements are found at <http://www.fhsu.edu/admissions/>.
