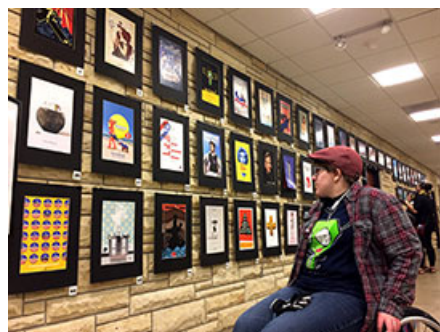
He will receive the award at the STEM Expo Monday and Tuesday, Oct. 10 and 11, in Branson, Mo. [More](#)

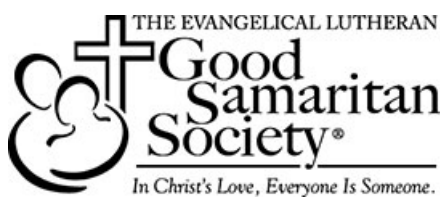
