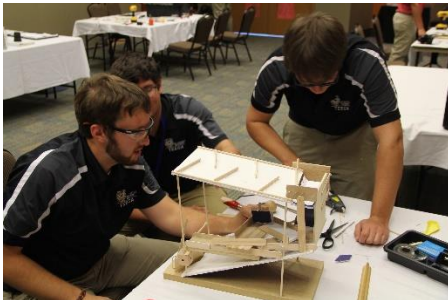


### [FHSU earns eight rankings in October](#)
