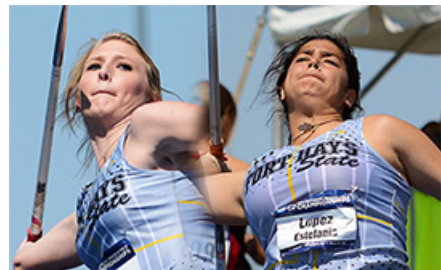
Groundbreaking ceremony set for new Fort Hays State track and field facility

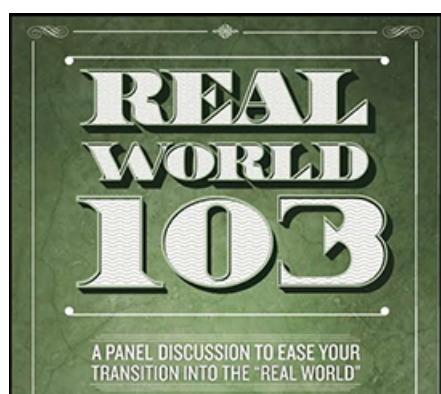


FHSU faculty receive tenure, promotion; retiring faculty, staff also honored
