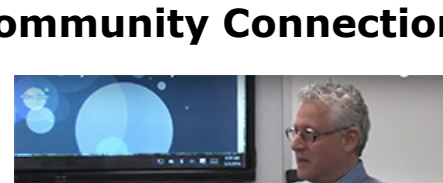


FHSU hires new chair for the Department of Teacher Education

After a national search, Dr. Chris Jochum was selected in April to become Fort Hays State University's new chair for the Department of Teacher Education. [More](#)

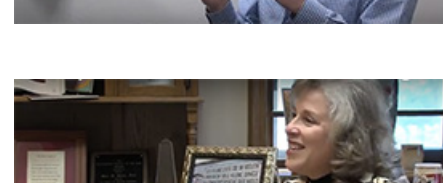
