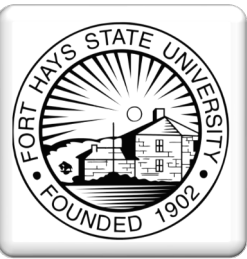

What is the KBOR Academic Year Reporting Dashboard?

The dashboard allows users to see various aspects of student data in a visual way based on data as submitted to KBOR for our annual reporting. The dashboard includes navigation tabs along with some detail on what each page will contain.

Academic years include Summer, Fall and Spring, with year of the Spring Semester being used. For example, Summer 2018, Fall 2018 and Spring 2019 are included in the Academic Year (AY) 2019. This dashboard includes data from AY19 to AY24.

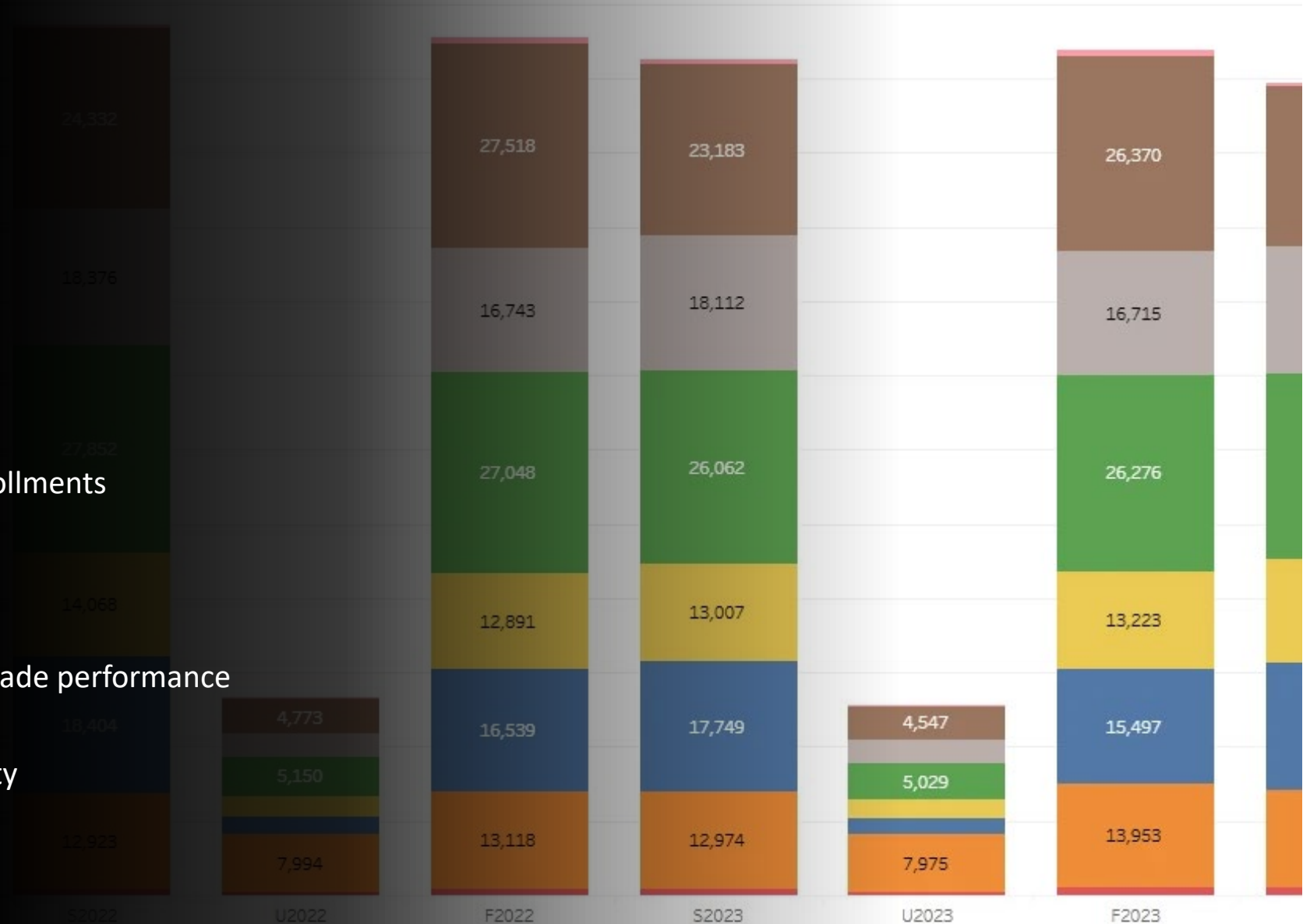

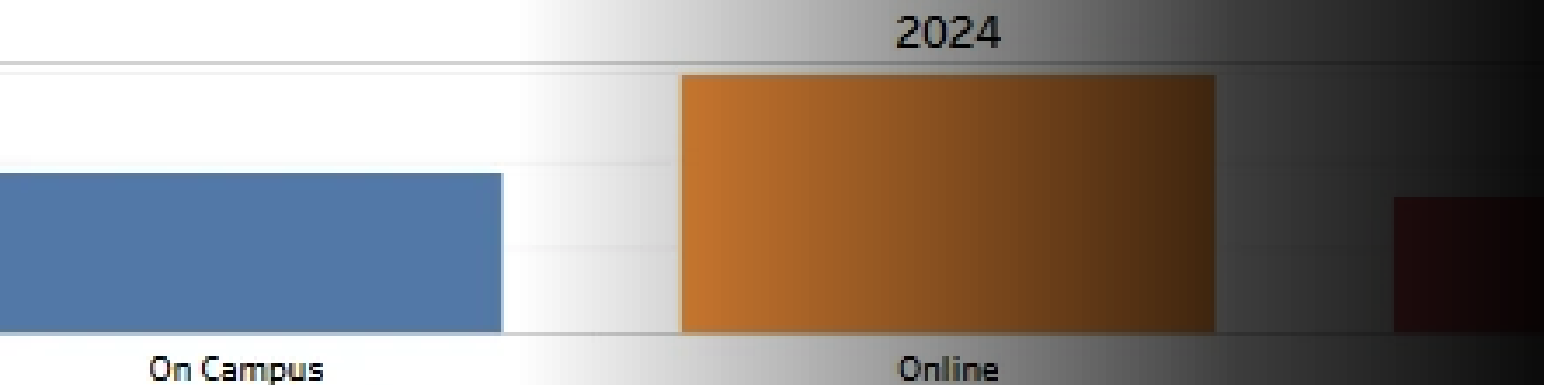

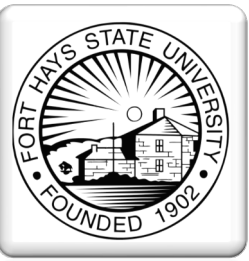

Within the State of Kansas includes six state universities, one municipal university, 19 community colleges, and six technical colleges. The Kansas Board of Regents governs the state university system over the other three types of postsecondary institutions. Annually, the system as a whole enrolls more than 250,000 students in a wide array of academic disciplines and degree programs. The system awards more than 42,000 credentials ranging from certificates to doctoral degrees.

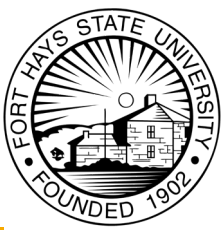
