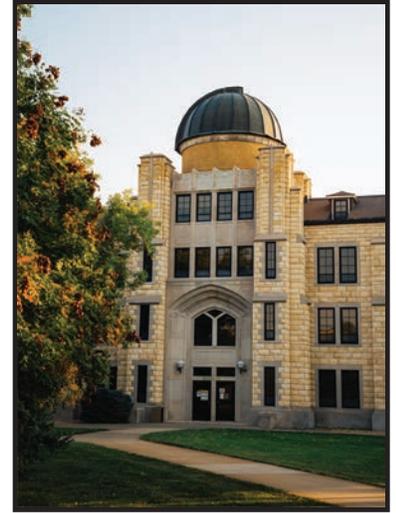

## University Farm

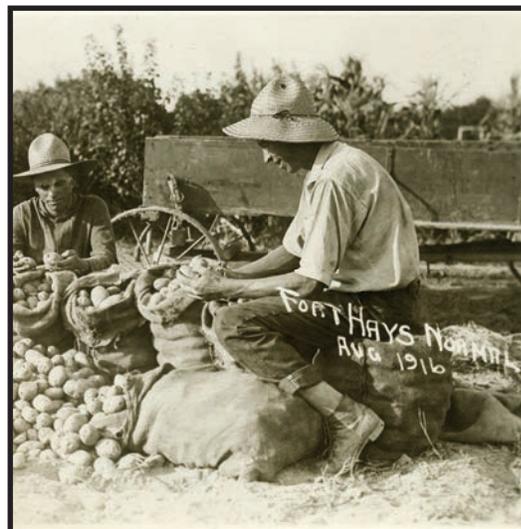
The Fort Hays State University Farm, with a rich history spanning over a century, provides students with unique hands-on experiences and practical exposure to production agriculture and management skills. Operating as a commercial farm on nearly 4,000 acres, it is a real-world laboratory for applying classroom knowledge and experiencing agricultural practice's in action.

### Key Details

- Beef Unit with over 200 Red Angus cows
- Sheep Unit
- Swine Unit
- Crops unit and pasture lands
- Part-time employment opportunities for students in various units
- Hosts educational sessions for various groups, including area school districts

### History

- Established by Principal William S. Picken in 1908.
- Expanded under President William Alexander Lewis to include raising crops, dairy, hog, and poultry to furnish food for the dining hall.
- Enough food was raised during WWI to make the school self-sufficient.
- Beginning in 1915, the field crops project allowed students to offset educational costs by growing and selling crops.
