





"I grew up in the Midwest and later moved to Florida for graduate school, where I stayed for over a decade. Returning to the Midwest now with my family has prompted a reflection on my upbringing and ties to the Midwest.


This series is an exploration of small towns and the dismissive notion encapsulated in the term "flyover states." During election seasons, news crews descend on these communities to capture sound bites and leave just as quickly, fleeting portraying these complex places into the stereotypes they see them as.

What begins as a few homes grows into a network of buildings: a church, a courthouse, a bar, a grocery store. These buildings become an integral part of the identity of the place. Photographing them in a way to reduce or remove labels blurs those lines of demarcation of each town or city, much in the same way outsiders might pass by them on the highway, making them visually interchangeable. Locals, however, will still be able to recognize some images with pride about their favorite store or memories created in a particular building. Ultimately, this series questions what defines a town. It moves beyond the familiar narratives of decline that are so often told." - Curt Steckel


