Attached are the routes available through Fort Hays State University to obtain teaching licensure. These options are within the parameters of the Kansas State Department of Education (KSDE) licensure regulations that all higher education institutions must abide by. Institutions within Kansas require different coursework, use different modes of delivery, and have different tuition rates, but all programs must be approved and meet the State standards and regulations.


FHSU offers traditional as well as alternative licensure programs. ALL of our programs are available online except for the major coursework for secondary subject areas in the traditional programs such as Art, Biology, Math, English, etc. Business education is, however, available online.

There are two new programs that FHSU has: Elementary Education - MSE (contact Dr. Valerie Zelenka, vzelenka@fhsu.edu) and Special Education - MS (contact Dr. Jackie Lubin, j_lubin@fhsu.edu). Both of these are graduate level programs that allow for working as a teacher of record while completing the coursework for full licensure for those that are not licensed teachers.


FHSU current tuition rates for online classes are \$218.67/credit hour (undergraduate), \$287.75/credit hour (graduate).

teaching not required.
- **GPA of 2.75+** in most recent 60 credit
hours

Professional Teaching License:

- Must complete course requirements
within two years
- Pass Praxis PLT test (5623)
- Pass performance assessment (KPTP)
- Master's degree available

- Must complete a bachelor's degree
- Complete education program, including a semester of student teaching
- Pass Praxis subject test (7811) and PLT (5622) licensure exams
- Pass performance assessment (KPTP)
- **Cannot be teacher of record until program completed.**

Elementary Education (grades K-6) Para Pathway

OPTION 2

Complete Para Pathway program to qualify for Initial Teaching License:

- Must complete bachelor's degree program in Elem Ed
- Complete 1 or 2 semester option for student teaching. 2 semester option allows half-time para employment and half-time student teaching.
- Pass Praxis subject test (7811) and PLT (5622) licensure exams
- Pass performance assessment (KPTP)
- **Cannot be teacher of record until program completed.**

Elementary Pilot graduate program to qualify for Limited Appr. License:

- Must have completed a bachelor's degree
- Complete a field experience (minimum 8 wks or full-time para) supervised by FHSU
- Complete some hours of program coursework

To complete the program and qualify for Initial Teaching License:

- Must complete remaining course requirements within two years
- **Can be hired as elementary classroom teacher of record while completing the program.**
- Complete mentor program
- Pass Praxis subject test (7811) and PLT (5622) licensure exams
- Pass performance assessment (KPTP)

- **GPA of 2.75+ on most recent 60 credit hours**

- **Must complete course requirements within two years**
- **Pass Praxis PLT test (5623 or 5624)**
- **Pass performance assessment (KPTP)**
- **Master's degree available**

- **Cannot be teacher of record** until program completed.

OPTION 2

High Incidence Special Education (grades P-12)

ONLINE

Completion traditional or alternative program for initial teaching license, then complete courses in the graduate program for the endorsement.

- **Can work as a special education teacher** on a Waiver or Provisional License while completing the program.
- Pass Praxis SPED test (5543)
- Master's degree available

OPTION 3

High Incidence Special Education (grades P-12) Limited Apprentice License

To qualify for Limited Apprentice License:

- Must have completed a bachelor's degree
- Have one year of experience as a special education para

- Complete 6-9 credit hours of program coursework

To complete the program and qualify for Initial Teaching License:

- Must complete remaining course requirements within two years
- **Must be hired as special education teacher of record** while completing the program
- Complete mentor program
- Pass Praxis SPED test (5543) and PLT (5623 or 5624)
- Pass performance assessment (KPTP)
- Master's degree available
