The Banking Certificate provides academic preparation for students who want to have a career in banking. To obtain a Banking Certificate, students must complete 12 hours as outlined below:

FIN 201 Principles of Banking
FIN 305 Managerial Finance (PR: ACCT 203 & MATH 250)
FIN 642 Bank Management (PR: FIN 201)
FIN 643 Bank Strategy (Capstone class – should be taken last)

(No grade lower than a “C” is acceptable for the classes taken in this certificate program.)

All classes for the Banking Certificate are available online.

To obtain your official certificate for the banking certificate program, please fill out the “Intent to Complete the Banking Certificate” form on the right side of this page, and return it to the Department of Economics, Finance, and Accounting. If you have met all the requirements, you should receive your certificate in the mail approximately 6-8 weeks from the date of approval.
