The Certificate in Finance is designed to provide a credential in finance for non-finance majors who want an endorsement of their knowledge in finance. To obtain a Certificate in Finance, students must complete 12 hours in finance as outlined below:

*FIN 305 Managerial Finance (PR: ACCT 203 & MATH 250)

*FIN 641 Financial Markets and Institutions (PR: FIN 305)

Plus any two of the following classes:

*FIN 311 Fundamentals of Investment (PR: FIN 305)

*FIN 405 Intermediate Finance (PR: FIN 305)

FIN 607 Options and Futures Markets (PR: FIN 305, FIN 311 & MATH 250)

FIN 611 Investment Theories and Strategies (PR: FIN 311)

*FIN 630 Insurance Planning

*FIN 645 International Finance (PR: FIN 305)

(No grade lower than a "C" is acceptable for the classes taken in this certificate program.)
