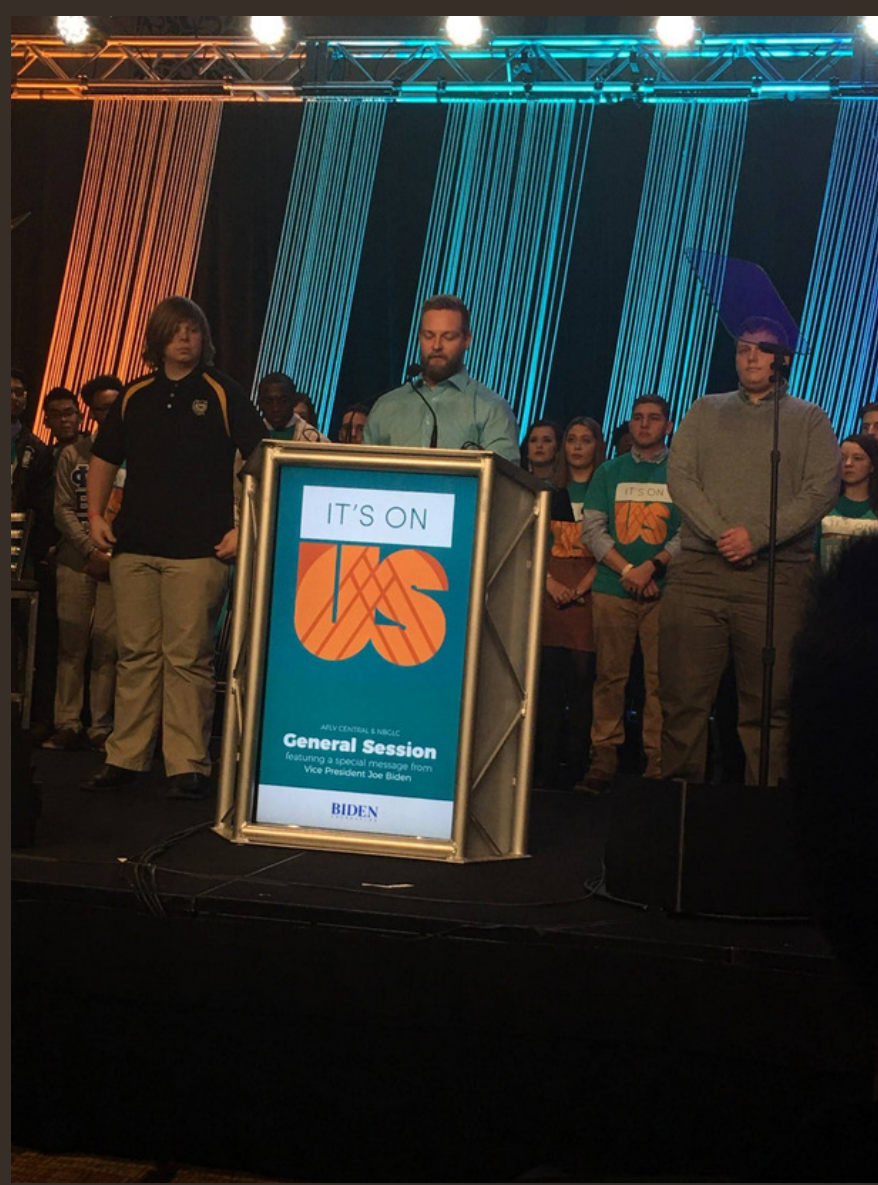

Walk - A - Mile In Her Shoes

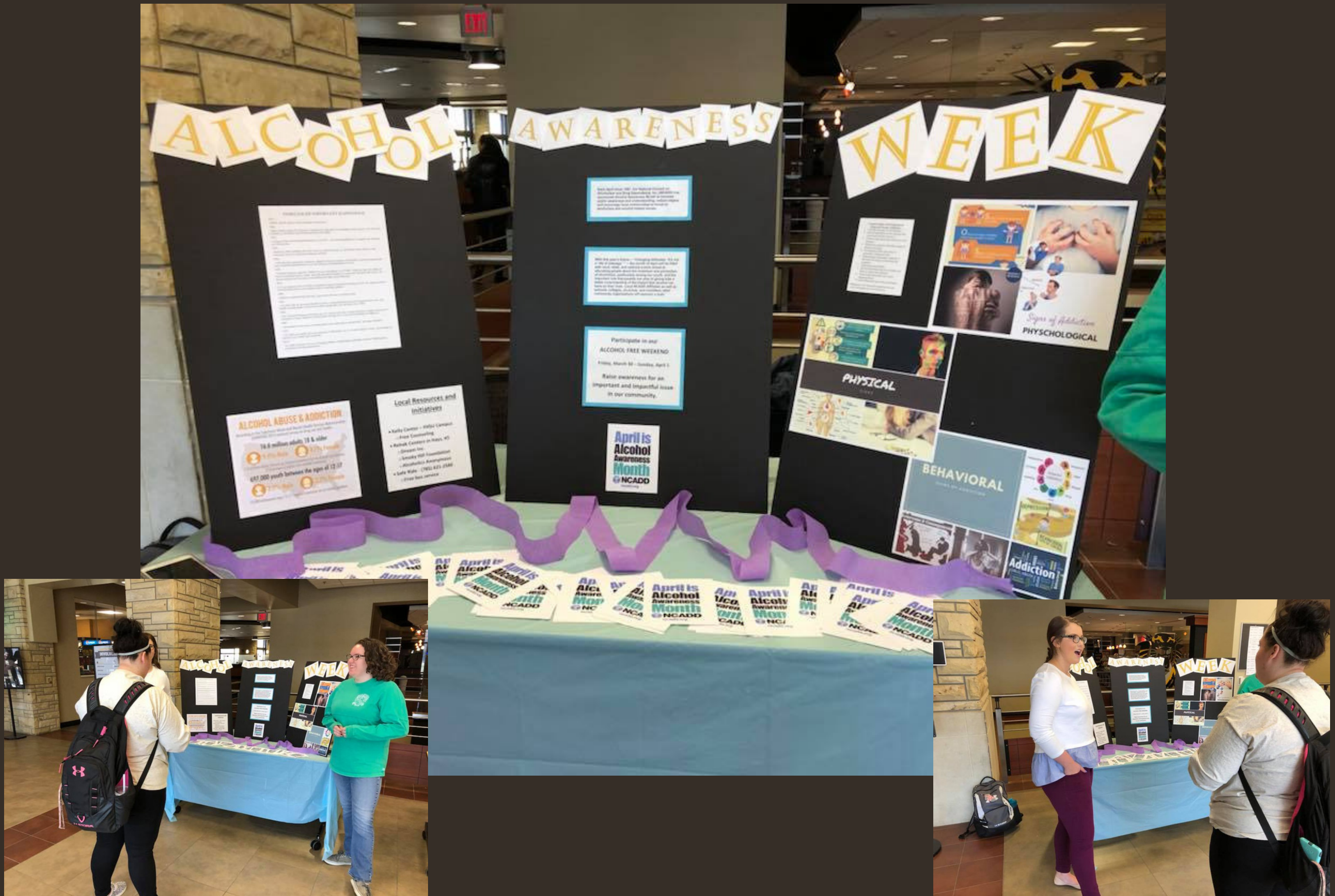
INTERFRATERNITY COUNCIL
