1. Design a research plan that (b) identifies appropriate information resources.	Appropriate resources are not identified.	Identifies types of information that are needed but that are not appropriate to the research question or assignment, uses inadequate resources for addressing the research question.	Identifies appropriate information needed as well as the resources needed. Research plan identifies appropriate information and types of sources needed to address the research question (library databases, peer-reviewed, academic, sociological).	In addition to proficiency, indicates above-average understanding of appropriate resources and develops a research plan that engages sociological scholarly resources and literature.
2. Produce a research log that clearly demonstrates the application of appropriate keyword search criteria, such as Boolean operators, source types, and filters.	Does not use research finding tools or keywords. Is not able to narrow search terms appropriately	Uses some research tools but not appropriate to the assignment, searches using keywords that do not meet the needs of the research project. Refines search, but does not appropriately use Boolean operators (AND, OR, NOT) or does not appropriately use filters. Identifies strategies for future research that does not	Uses appropriate research tools, names resources used, searches using appropriate keywords and refines searches appropriately using Boolean operators (AND, OR, NOT) and by using appropriate filters. Write an annotated bibliography that (a) critically analyzes the context, relevance, and authority of information sources, particularly in light of new perspectives, additional voices, and changes in schools of thought.	Does not summarize sources clearly or in own words. No analysis of source context. Sources are not appropriate for the concept and/or does not explain why the sources were chosen.	Annotations provide unclear summarizations and use many direct quotes. Demonstrate lacking understanding of context and relevance of each source. Does not articulate why sources relate to the assignment.	Constructs clear annotations that summarize without quoting directly. Appropriately addresses the context and relevance of each source and expresses why the sources relate to the assignment.	Produce excellent annotations that carefully summarize each resource with in-depth demonstration of the context of each resource as it relates to the overall topic and the field of sociology. Skillfully articulates how the sources relate to one another and support the research project.
3. Write an annotated bibliography that (b) applies appropriate disciplinary conventions of citation.	Does not provide citation for the course. Little or no adherences to ASA formatting.	Provides identifying information but not a full or clear citation. Includes errors in citation style.	Provides full and accurate citation, may not be in ASA format. Any errors do not impede understanding or location of citation.	Provides full and accurate citation in ASA format with no formatting errors.
