

FHSU Offices to Contact

Americans with Disabilities Act

Disability issues are handled by a variety of offices on the FHSU campus. Below is a list of those offices and a brief description of the types of issues handled by each:

Equal Employment Opportunity Office: The EEO Office (628-4462) deals with concerns of discrimination or harassment based upon disability.

Coordinator of Services for Students with Disabilities: The Coordinator of Services for Students with Disabilities is located in the Kelly Center (628-4401). This is the appropriate office for students, faculty or staff to contact to notify the university of a student's disability and initiate a request for a service. Students and faculty may also contact the office to coordinate disability services for learning disabled and cognitively impaired students.

Herndon Speech-Language-Hearing Clinic: Students, faculty and staff may contact the Herndon SpeechLanguage-Hearing Clinic (628-5366) for comprehensive services in speech, language and hearing.

Human Resource Office: The Human Resource Office (628-4462) is the appropriate office for University Support Staff or Unclassified Professional Staff to contact to notify the university of the disability and to initiate a request for reasonable accommodation.

Kelly Center: The Kelly Center (628-4401) provides a variety of services to FHSU students, faculty and staff. Services include academic support career planning programs, alcohol/drug assistance, personal counseling, psychological services and standardized testing (ACT, PPST, GRE, etc.).

Physical Plant: The Physical Plant (628-4424) is responsible for building and grounds maintenance. Concerns regarding items such as snow removal, operation of elevators and automatic door openers, door hardware, restroom fixtures and furniture design or layout may be addressed through this office.

Student Health Center: The Student Health Center (628-4293) is available to students, faculty and staff to promote health and to treat acute illnesses as well as some chronic diseases. Staff can assist with physician referrals.

University Police: Students may contact the University Police office (625-5304) in case of emergency.
