STAYING LEGAL F1 & J1 BASICS

- KEEP PASSPORT VALID carry with you at all times, especially when traveling (in the US and abroad).
 - RENEW passport at least six months BEFORE expiration date.
- Always follow U.S. CUSTOMS & BORDER PATROL ENTRY AND EXIT PROCEDURES. Review any updates before traveling, it is your responsibility to know current regulations.
- Know I-20 or DS-2019 EXPIRATION DATE. If necessary, request an extension BEFORE document expires.
- Keep LOCAL ADDRESS CURRENT verify in TigerTracks and notify International Student Services Office.
- Follow SPECIAL REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS, if applicable. ENTRY/EXIT TO UNITED STATES:
- AFTER EACH ENTRY to the US, print ELECTRONIC I-94 and bring PASSPORT to ISSO to copy annotated stamp.
- PRIOR to leaving US, confirm I-20 or DS-2019 has been PROPERLY SIGNED for travel by ISSO office. Failure to have proper signature could result in denial entry to US.
- Upon COMPLETION of degree or exchange program, F1 students must exit the US in 60 days and J1 students must exit the US in 30 days.

EDUCATION:

- UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS: complete minimum 12 HOURS of courses each semester.
- GRADUATE STUDENTS: complete minimum 9 HOURS of course work each semester.
- Request a NEW I-20 or DS-2019 for any CHANGE IN MAJOR or grade level
- Notify the ISSO advisor BEFORE dropping classes.
- Attend CPT AND OPT WORKSHOPS to hear current regulation requirements.
- Notify ISSO if you plan to TRANSFER to another college or university. WORK:
- May work less than 20 hours ON CAMPUS ONLY when classes are in session.
- Notify ISSO BEFORE OFF CAMPUS EMPLOYMENT (including internships, assistantships, etc.)
 - Must have proper AUTHORIZATION FOR WORK OFF CAMPUS, failure to follow regulations could result in out of status.
