

# KANSAS ACADEMY OF MATHEMATICS AND SCIENCE

- Established by legislative action in 2006 by Senate Bill 139.
- Kansas' first and only fully immersive residential early college program.
- One of six on-campus Residential Early College Programs



### STUDENT SELECTION

Applicants are high school 10th graders who have completed Geometry and Algebra II. Students are selected based on ACT or SAT scores; academic grades from 9th and 10th grades; responses to essay questions; recommendation of teachers, leadership and involvement. KAMS can take up to 40 new KAMS Juniors a year. In addition, AMS students are required to submit a language proficiency score as well as be interviewed.

### STUDENT TRANSCRIPTS

Transcripts include grades earned from the student's sending high school (9th and 10th years) along with grades earned from Fort Hays State University (11th and 12th years).

It is suggested to sending high schools to record FHSU courses in the following manner:

- FHSU one credit hour course = .25 credit
- FHSU two credit hour course = 1/2 credit (semester)
- FHSU three credit hour course = 1/2 credit (semester)
- FHSU four or five credit hour course = 1 credit (year)

KAMS and AMS students submit a FHSU transcript and their sending high school's transcript during the college application process. For AMS students this is Thomas-More Prep Marian High School transcript.

Unweighted GPA's are reported on a 4.0 scale.

Early College Programs|KAMS/AMS does not rank students or their GPAs.



# ACADEMY OF MATHEMATICS AND SCIENCE

- Established to accommodate KAMS program's growing out-of-state and international populations.
- AMS students' sending high school is Thomas More Prep-Marian (TMP-M) High School, Hays, Kansas.
- TMP-M is one of the state's top private high schools. AMS students only take classes at Fort Hays State University.
