What's in it for me?

Not only will you enhance your leadership skills outside of the classroom environment, but upon completion of *The Quest* you will be presented with a certificate of completion and a cord to wear at commencement.

How much time does this take?

There are specific requirements established to complete *The Quest*. These can be completed throughout your time at FHSU. Below are the requirements for completion of the program.

- ◆ Attend an approved leadership retreat
- ◆ Attend 15 Quest selected activities
- ◆ Attend a Sebelius Lecture Series event
- ◆ Complete a StrengthsQuest assessment and reflection
- ◆ Pass the LDRS 300-Introduction to Leadership Concepts course
