
Forsyth Library 2020-2021 Year at a Glance

COVID-19 dramatically decreased the use of the physical library and increased the use of the online library during FY21.


After a campus shutdown in March 2020, the library began a phased reopening starting in July with socially distanced furniture and limited hours and spaces which was maintained throughout the rest of the academic year.


