Marching Band Eligibility

The FHSU Tiger Marching Band is open to all FHSU students and all Kansas Academy of Math and Science (KAMS) students. Marching Band responsibilities begin in August at the Marching Band Camp and extend through all post-season football games in November and December. Band members will receive a stipend for their participation in the Marching Band. To be eligible for the stipend, band members must meet all attendance requirements for the entire season. Online Membership Form

All band members (new and returning) need to complete the **Online Membership Form** each year. We will be ordering t-shirts before camp begins based on the sizes you submit on this form.

Enrollment Required

All band members are required to enroll in MUS 601. You may choose Section A (1 credit), Section B (2 credits), or Section C (0 credits). Enrolling for credit will affect your cumulative GPA. Enrolling for no credit, does not affect your GPA but your grade will still appear on your transcript.

Wind Ensemble and Symphonic Winds

The **Wind Ensemble** is FHSU's premier concert band and is selected by auditions that will be held on Wednesday August 23rd 3:30-5:30pm. Rehearsals for the Wind Ensemble will begin Wednesday August 30th 3:30-5:30pm.

The **Symphonic Winds** is a large concert band open to all at the university, no audition required. Symphonic Winds is now only offered in the Spring semester.

Rehearsal Schedule

MUS 601 appears on the schedule as Monday, Wednesday, Thursday. Starting Spring 2024, MUS 601 and MUS 602 will change to Monday, Wednesday, Friday. On Wednesdays, only Wind Ensemble members are required to attend.

Class Conflicts

Occasionally, university classes will conflict with band rehearsals. As long as the conflict is not excessive, accommodations to arrive late or leave early are usually possible. Contact the director by email if this applies to you and sign-up on the Class Conflict Form that will be posted at band camp. Work schedules, applied lessons, and non-university related activities should not conflict with band rehearsals.

Stipends

All Marching Band members will receive a stipend after the football season ends. In order to receive the stipend, band members must enroll in a minimum of six credit hours during the fall semester including MUS 601, meet all attendance and conduct requirements, and *fill out their employment paperwork including any onboarding in Workday* with **FHSU Student Employment** (Sheridan Hall-112). Stipend amounts are:

1st year: \$500 2nd year: \$550 3rd year: \$600 4-6th year: \$650

Stipends are processed only after the last post season game and are usually available in your account by late December or early January. Stipend bonuses are awarded at the discretion of the Director for students completing extra duties. Stipends will not be awarded to students past the 6th year of participation without approval from the Director.

Miller Award

Non-music major instrumentalists in good academic standing are also eligible for an additional \$200 through the Miller Award. This money is awarded automatically following the 20th day of classes to the account used to pay your tuition. To qualify, students must be enrolled in a minimum of six credit hours during the fall semester with at least a 2.0 GPA. Colorguard and KAMS students are not eligible for the Miller Award.

Music Distribution

PRINT your own music before band camp. Access the band google drive from a computer (not a cell phone) using your FHSU student account. The Tiger Marching Band plays all field shows from memory and it is helpful for all to arrive at band camp with the Fight Song and Tiger Rag already memorized. Instruments

FHSU provides piccolos, sousaphones, mellophones, baritones, and drums free of charge. We have a limited supply of other instruments including clarinets, saxophones, and trombones. **Email the director if you need to check out an instrument.** Instruments may be checked out over the summer by appointment or after band camp registration in August.

Flip Folders, Lyres, Reeds, Maintenance Items

All instrumentalists are expected to purchase their own flip folder with 20 pages, a lyre to attach the flip folder to the instrument, reeds, straps, and all necessary maintenance items (valve oil, slide cream, etc.) needed to keep equipment in good working order on a daily basis. *These materials WILL NOT* be ordered through the FHSU Marching Band. Uniforms

You will be fitted for a uniform during band camp. There is no charge to use FHSU uniforms. Uniforms **MUST** be returned in good condition at the end of the season. Damage beyond normal wear and tear will result in charges to your student account for the cost to repair or replace the item. Proper uniform care will be presented at band camp and regular uniform inspections will occur before each performance.

On-Campus Housing and Move In

Band members living on campus will be allowed to move into their dorms early for band camp free of charge. Move in days will be **Thursday August 10th** for Colorguard and Drumline, **Friday August 11th** for Band Leaders, and **Sunday**, **August 13th** for all others. Please see the Band Camp Schedule for updated move-in times. KAMS students should contact the KAMS office to make move in arrangements.

Meningitis Policy

Before you can move into university or Greek housing, FHSU health policy requires all students to get a meningitis vaccine or sign a waiver. On-Campus Meals During Band Camp

Fall semester meal plans begin on Wednesday of Band Camp. Before Wed., students will need to provide their own meals. Required Marching Band Attire, Optional Attire, and Other Expenses

Every effort is made to keep out-of-pocket expenses associated with the Tiger Marching Band to a minimum. When registering for Band Camp, please expect to purchase the items listed below. Payment may be made by cash, check (FHSU Music), debit card, or credit card. There is no need to purchase these items early. We will place one big order during band camp to arrive before the first game.

8.25% Sales Tax Will be Added to All Sales...Cash, Check (made out to FHSU Music), and Credit Cards Accepted *All instrumentalists are required to have marching shoes designed specifically for marching that are entirely black (Dinkles, Drill Masters, etc.). You may use black marching shoes you already own, however, tennis shoes, sneakers, or shoes with any color besides black are not acceptable.

Additional Marching Band Clothing and Merchandise

Students and their families and friends will have an opportunity to purchase additional clothing and merchandise during the season (usually by the end of September). Past items have included t-shirts for parents, polo shirts, sweatshirts, sweatshirts, blankets, pajama pants, etc. Details regarding these optional purchases will be sent out later. Sections also often choose to create section-specific clothing. Section Leaders coordinate these purchases.
