**Guaranteed Admission Requirements for the following Kansas Community Colleges:** 

Barton County, Butler, Coffeyville, Cloud County, Colby, Dodge City, Fort Scott, Garden City, Highland, Hutchinson, Johnson County, Kansas City Kansas, Labette, Neosho County, Seward County.

- 1. An unencumbered active RN license issued in the United States.
- Cumulative GPA or Associate in Nursing Degree GPA ≥ 2.5. Students that do not meet the Cumulative GPA or Associate in Nursing Degree GPA ≥ 2.5 may be admitted on probation if their cumulative GPA and Associate in Nursing Degree is 2.0-2.49.
- 3. Must have earned a "C" or better in any FHSU RN to BSN course and have a ≥ 2.5 FHSU Major GPA that was taken prior to applying.
- 4. International students with an F1 or F2 visa do not qualify for this program.
- 5. Must meet university requirements for any transfer credits.
- 6. We do not accept applications from students residing in Tennessee, Washington, and Alabama.

University requirements include:

- Students who have a current U.S. RN license with transcripts from outside the United States
  must have two evaluations completed on his/her transcripts: <u>WES+</u> and <u>CGFNS</u>.
- Students whose native language is not English are required to take the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL).
