



POLICY TITLE: Proposed Resolution – Master of Liberal Studies

POLICY STATEMENT: Considering that (1) faculty and departments expend significant amounts of resources to assist graduate students pursuing a Master of Liberal Studies (MLS) degree, (2) the 21 hour concentration involves advising and individual supervision of graduate students, and (3) there is a need to recognize the faculty and departments who work with MLS students, the Graduate Council of Fort Hays State University recommends that:

- each graduate student pursuing an MLS degree be counted as one student for the faculty advisor and the department in which the student has a concentration;
- 2. each graduate student who graduates with an MLS degree be counted as one graduating student for the department in which the student has a concentration;
- 3. the count of MLS students be kept separate from the count of graduate students of a department; and
- 4. the MLS data be used primarily for internal evaluation, with use externally on an as-needed basis.
