POLICY STATEMENT: Add Policy Statement: Students may officially enroll in or add full-semester courses up to and including the 7th calendar day after classes begin. All open, full-semester classes (16 weeks) offered through the Virtual College will officially close 14 calendar days after the start of each semester. Courses offered through the Virtual College that meet for less than a full semester will follow the guidelines shown in the chart below.
