POLICY STATEMENT: In order to accurately reflect all grades on incoming, post-secondary transcripts from students who receive credit from other regionally accredited universities, the following grade conversion/point conversion will be applied. This applies to only courses that are transferable to FHSU. This policy is effective for all new incoming students Fall 2010 and beyond.
