

### Legislative Update

- ➤ Governor's Budget = \$8.9M Approximately \$379,000 for FHSU
- ➤ Budget Conference Committee = \$7.5M *Approximately* \$326,000 for FHSU
- ➤ House & Senate Budget Committees = \$12M Approximately \$540,000 for FHSU






### Legislative Update

- The 2.5% increase for salaries has been moved to Omnibus.
- ➤ Approximately 1/3 of our positions are funded by state general fund dollars
- At 2.5% our investment would be approximately \$1.5M








### FY 2020 Budgeted Revenues






### FY 2020 Budgeted Expenditures

- Reduced eligibility period for tuition assistance from three years to one year.



## Investments in People 2018-2019 Faculty Professional Development Funds

- \$200,000 allocated
- > \$205,000 awarded
  - \$185,000 to individual faculty
  - \$20,000 to campus initiatives (new faculty activities, Tiger Leaders, Tilford, etc.)
- Individual Faculty Awards
  - \* Mean: \$852
  - ❖ Median: \$1,000
  - \* Mode: \$1,200






