

Investing in People Move to Market*

- ➤ This initiative is a \$2M+ investment over four years.
- The move to market initiative is solely focused on ensuring our employees are being paid at least market wages.
- ➤ Those eligible for a market increase will see an increase in their January 25th paycheck.

* Contingent on availability of funding.





Investing in People Move to Market*

- ➤ Within the annual review and contract renewal cycle, merit and other compensation changes will continue.
- ➤ All wage data will be reviewed during the contract cycle to consider additional adjustments due to compression, equity, or inversion.

- ➤ Add December ceremony in 2019



Fall 2018 Projects



Gross/Cunningham Hall
Exterior Door Replacement
R&R Funding

Upgrade the exterior doors to Gross and Cunningham Halls for electronic access.



Stroup Hall Simulation Labs University & Private Funds

Remodel and equipment upgrades the department of nursing simulation labs.



Street and Pedestrian R&R Funding

New LED light poles along Lyman Dr. New pedestrian lighting by Tomanek Hall and Forsyth Library.



Sidewalk Repairs/Replacement General Repairs R&R Funding

Replace deteriorating areas of sidewalks and add accessible ramps.



McCartney & Albertson Hall Masonry Cleaning R&R Funding

Clean and seal exterior masonry on McCartney and Albertson Halls.



Malloy Hall Lobby Tile Replacement R&R Funding

The main lobby of Malloy was updated with new ceramic tile.

Design work is in progress for improvements to the ballroom ceiling and to renovate the union restrooms.

University Funds

Center for Student Sucess Private Funds / Tuition & Bonds

Design work is now underway on the (3) story addition.



Akers Energy Center Boiler Replacement R&R Funding

Includes abatement work and removal and replacement of two boilers.



Animal Research Addition

An addition to the existing animal research house to accommodate the department of agriculture's drones.



Rarick Hall Renovation
University Funds


Programming is in development for the renovation of Rarick.



Investing in Place: Workday

- ➤ Reinstated bi-monthly workday newsletter
- ➤ Made decision to remain with our current financial aid system until Workday is more advanced/integrated
- ➤ Negotiated commitment from Workday to forgo two years of payments (saving \$730,000 per year) for student module






Investing in Place: WorkDay

- ➤ Planning event during the last week in January to update our project plan
- Improving admissions & recruiting functions
- ➤ Developing an external site for undergraduate applications
- ➤ Testing courses loaded into the tenant and then move courses to production







Investing in Purpose:

International Staff Organization

Design a staffing plan to further empower our employees to educate and deliver services in a coherent and strategic direction.


