IMPROVEMENTS ARE ON THE WAY FOR THE 2024-25 FAFSA PROCESS

Some key changes include replacing Expected Family Contribution (EFC) with Student Aid Index (SAI) calculation to determine eligibility for need-based funding. Rather than importing their tax information using the IRS Data Retrieval Tool, applicants will consent to provide their Federal Tax Information (FTI) via a direct data share with the IRS. Having an FSA ID (account username and password) is the only way for students and parents to access or correct information online.
