



Research Security Training (RST)

All NSF (National Science Foundation), NIH (National Institutes of Health), DOE (Department of Energy), DOD (Department of Defense), and USDA (US Department of Agriculture) grant applicants and recipients must complete research security training (RST) as required by [National Security Presidential Memorandum-33 \(NSPM-33\)](#) and the [CHIPS and Science Act of 2022](#).

Personnel must complete the RST within 12 months of applying for a grant and annually after receiving an award through the above-listed entities.

Individuals needing to complete the training include:

- Principal investigators (PIs).
- Co-PIs.
- Senior/key personnel listed on a research and development award application. (NSF definition [here](#))
- Subrecipient senior/key personnel named in the proposal.
- New individuals added to a project - must complete the training within 30 days of joining.
