Instructions to utilize the Spring 2026 Semester-at-a-Glance Calendar

The purpose of this time management tool is to provide students with a comprehensive view of the semester. Using this one-page tool, write down all the due dates you have on your syllabi – homework, exams, midterms, lab reports, projects, finals, and other graded assignments.

Consider including major social/extracurricular events to have a complete picture of the semester: birthdays, club meetings, trips, etc. You can add events that you consider significant.

Optional: Some students find it helpful to color-code their Semester-at-a-Glance by subject, type of assignment, or activity. You can also include how much each assignment is worth. Customize this time management tool to fit your needs.

Notes

Interim Grades are issued for all students enrolled in 16-week courses, for both on-campus and online sections. These are issued to help students determine their academic standing and identify opportunities to use the academic resources available on campus. Interim Grades can be accessed in Workday.
