University Wide Degree Requirements

GPA Requirement

FHSU considers the following three GPAs: all coursework GPA, FHSU coursework GPA, and the major coursework GPA. This program requires GPA to be 2.00 or higher.

Upper Division Requirement

All degrees require a minimum of 45 hours of upper division credit. To qualify, the institution granting the credit must grant the majority of its degrees at the baccalaureate level or above and consider the credit to be upper division or junior level and above. Courses anticipated to meet this requirement are denoted with a U in the Division (D) designation.

120 Credit Hour Requirement

All FHSU degrees require a minimum of 120 credit hours.
