University Wide Degree Requirements

GPA Requirement

FHSU considers the following three GPAs: all coursework GPA, FHSU coursework GPA, and the major coursework GPA. All FHSU degrees require 2.0 GPA. Some programs have higher GPA requirements.

Upper Division Requirement

All degrees require a minimum of 45 hours of upper division credit. To qualify, the institution granting the credit must grant the majority of its degrees at the baccalaureate level or above and consider the credit to be upper division or junior level and above. Courses anticipated to meet this requirement are denoted with a U in the Division (D) designation.

120 Credit Hour Requirement

All FHSU degrees require a minimum of 120 credit hours.

Additional Notes

Students transferring 63 hours or fewer [Maximum of 48 non-general education] can complete the degree in 120 hours provided completion of at least 4 credit hours of upper division courses applicable to general education requirements at FHSU. In limited circumstances, students transferring more than 63 hours may be able to complete in 120 hours. Degrees with more than 15 credit hours of general education applicable courses [up to 10 CH], or degrees with courses articulated to a program requirement [up to 8 CH] may be able to apply the additional hours with careful planning. It is likely that hours over 63 taken in the initial degree will not apply to the 120 hours for this degree.

Key

C= Course Option: credit hours typically equal to calculated option.

T= Transfer: credit hours counted elsewhere in articulation or course indicated in transfer degree.

O = Course is optional in Degree or GE. Class is an option listed in the transfer degree.

P = Possible Course: Identified course offering at the transfer school but is not in degree plan. Note: substituting or completing additional course hours may not reduce time to degree, discuss with advisors to determine the actual result of proposed variations.

R = Recommended: Course required for the FHSU degree, completion in SGE/transfer degree is recommended as the most efficient route to the degree.

S = Suggested: Course is an option to meet a requirement in the FHSU Degree.

E = Encouraged: Course has relevance to the degree, typically applies as elective credit, but may satisfy a concentration option.
