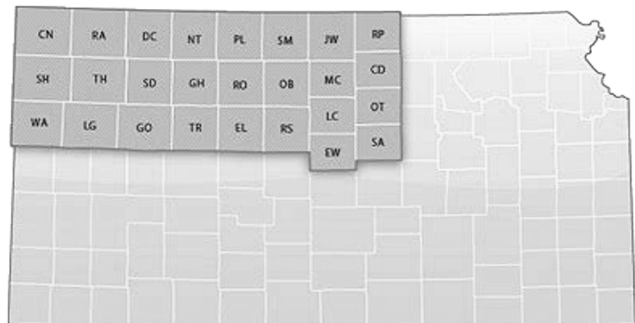
Requirements
