Includes field experiences and one semester of student teaching. Cannot work as a teacher of record until the program is finished.

SCIENCE TEACHERS FOR RURAL AMERICA (STRA) SCHOLARSHIP

ONLINE

(30 cr hrs / MSE 39 cr hrs)

Requires a science degree and intent to teach middle or high school science in a rural school. Must pass relevant Praxis test within first 9 credit hours of program.

Must complete 2 years of teaching in a high-needs rural district.

Eligible for licensure after successful completion of 30 credit hours.

TRANSITION TO TEACHING

ONLINE

(24 cr hrs / MSE 36 cr hrs)

Requires a degree in the content area or equivalent coursework. Available for all subject areas.

Must find employment as a teacher of record in Kansas under Restricted License.

Relevant Praxis test must be passed to enter.

Eligible for full licensure after successful completion of 24 credit hours.

REGISTERED TEACHER APPRENTICESHIP

Candidates must work part-time or full-time for a district in Kansas as an apprentice.

Only for secondary online programs Business, English, Spanish, History, Earth and Space Science, and

Special Education (High/Low Incidence)

Will receive \$7500 Scholarship per year.

ELEMENTARY EDUCATION T2T PROGRAM

TRACK #1- Transition to Teaching

(27 cr hrs / MSE 36 cr hrs)

Can be employed as teacher of record in Kansas after 1 semester of coursework under the LERP License (Limited Elementary Residency Program).

MSE- ELEMENTARY EDUCATION PROGRAM

Track #2 - Traditional Program

(27 cr hrs / MSE 36 cr hrs)

Eligible for PreK-6 licensure after successful completion of 27 credit hours.

ELEMENTARY EDUCATION POST-BACC PROGRAM

TRACK #3 - Licensed Teachers

(27 cr hrs / MSE 36 cr hrs)

Adds an Elementary Endorsement (PreK-6) to a Non-Elementary Teaching License. Candidates must possess either an ECU, Middle/High School or Special Education Teaching License.

Includes internships, field experience, and one semester of student teaching.

Available for Elementary Education, Elementary Education with a minor in Special Education & Early Childhood Unified

Will receive \$7500 Scholarship per year
