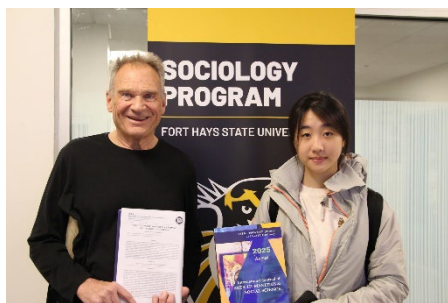

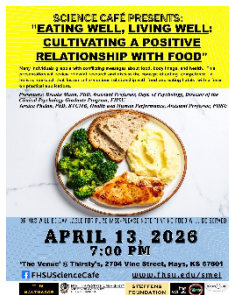
FHSU STEM EDUCATION STUDENTS GAIN HANDS-ON LEARNING EXPERIENCE IN CHICAGO
