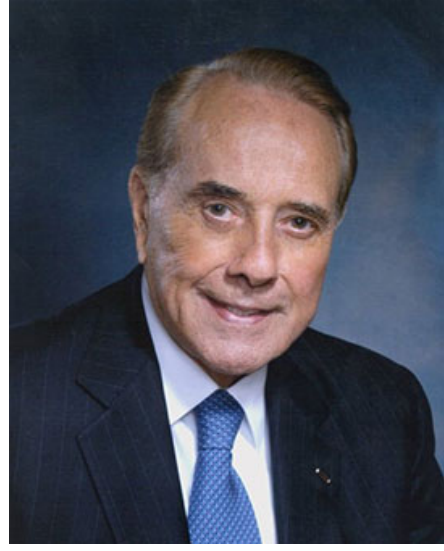

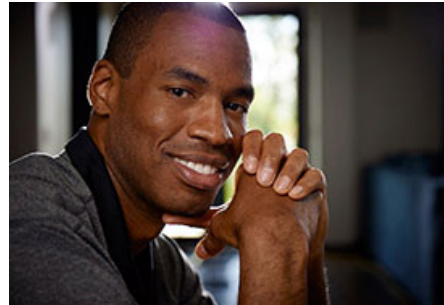


ROBERT J. DOLE: FHSU will award honorary Doctor of Arts degree; renowned statesman will give Commencement address

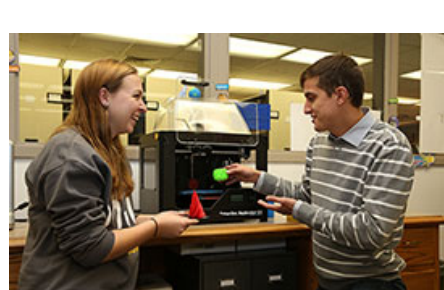

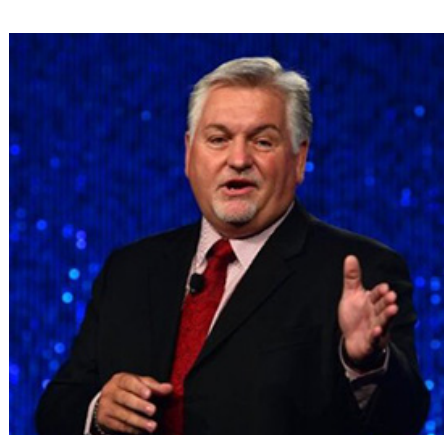


FHSU's MDC offers advanced grant writing workshop
